As this is taking place the first weekend of summer, we don't anticipate the cold being an issue. Via extension cords there will be access to hydro, and cold water via outdoor taps. Please ensure that you bring a kettle if you require hot/warm water.

We reserve the right to split a tent with another workshop - however, the minimum tent size is 10x20, and we will include a visual barrier between the two workshops if this is required.

Please return the below application form by April 15th to be considered for the 2020 Show. We will be accepting applications on an ongoing basis, so the sooner your application arrives, the better!

As a workshop leader, you agree to the following:

- a) All booth material/kits must stay within the designated boundaries of the rented space
- b) Your workshop will remain open and ready for business for the full designated time and location of the Muskoka Yarn & Fibrefest. Failure to comply with this will result in the Workshop Leader being barred from future Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest events.
- c) Your company will promote Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest 2020 through your blog, newsletters, social media, networking and distribution of Flyers (physical copies available upon request)
- d) Courtesy and respect must be extended to Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest representatives by ALL persons associated with your workshop leadership. Please remember that most are volunteers and make this event possible.

### **Workshop Leader Information Package**

Upon arrival, Workshop Leaders must report to the registration table under the blue tent near the front door. Please pickup your workshop package, which will include your name tags, and show information.

## Signage:

You must not affix anything to the walls or floors. Any damage to the walls or floors by affixing items will be the sole responsibility of the workshop leader to cover the costs of repairs.





### Parking:

Friday, June 28th, 2020 - Please move your vehicles away from the loading doors immediately upon completion of unloading. All vehicles must be removed from the parking lot by 9:30pm. No overnight parking is permitted.

Saturday, June 29th, 2020: You can unlaod your vehicle at your tent ONE HOUR before the start of your workshop. After unloading, you must IMMEDIATELY moved to the designed vendor parking lot. This will be strictly enforced. If you're unloading past the beginning of your workshop time, Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest reserves the right to ban you from future events.

**Insurance**: All vendors are required to provide a copy of the Proof of insurance stating that they hold a minimum of \$2 Million General Liability Insurance and \$250,000 Tenant Legal Liability insurance. Vendors must include the Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest and Wool Interrupted as co-insured for the duration of the Fibrefest. The information required is as follows:
