We reserve the right to accept or deny applications to create a well rounded show, featuring yarn, fibre and finished objects to bring in the widest audience possible for your booth.

About our Space:

The Bracebridge Agricultural Hall has over 12,000 square feet of space for our vendors in two large halls, plus a large horse ring and livestock pens.

Please note, there is **no wifi available in this space**, although cell reception is very good. We do our best to bring an ATM to the site for the show.

- Will be a minimum of 10x10.
- Tables & Chairs are available free of charge.
- Must provide & use a tablecloth and must be skirted to the floor

Each Market Table:

- Will have a minimum 6ft table provided, as well as two chairs.

Each Outdoor Booth:

- Will be a minimum of 10x10.
- Tables & Chairs are available free of charge.
- Must provide & use a tablecloth and must be skirted to the floor
- Will have access to volunteers for bathroom breaks, lunches etc. and there will be a phone number provided for you to request services
- Must have an adequate shelter for booth and wares, provided at your own expense.
- Will include admission for two people

Each Livestock Space:

- Will be a minimum of 10x10.
- Tables & Chairs are available free of charge.
- Must provide & use a tablecloth and must be skirted to the floor
- Will have access to volunteers for bathroom breaks, lunches etc. and there will be a phone number provided for you to request services
- Must have an adequate shelter **and fencing** for booth, wares, and livestock, provided at your own expense.
- Will include admission for two people

** Outdoor & Livestock Spaces are offered at a reduced rate as we cannot predict the weather. Please ensure that your tent has walls to protect your goods and animals, as this is a rain or shine event.

You are only permitted to break down your booth early due to weather when thunder/lightning is present or a weather warning has been issued**



Terms & Conditions:

As a vendor, you agree to the following:

- a) All booth material/merchandise must stay within the designated boundaries of the rented space
- b) Your booth will remain open and ready for business for the full Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest Marketplace Hours (Saturday, July 2nd, 2022 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM). Failure to comply with this will result in the vendor being barred from future Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest events.
- c) Your company will promote Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest 2022 through your blog, newsletters, social media, networking and distribution of Flyers (physical copies available upon request)
- d) Courtesy and respect must be extended to Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest representatives by ALL persons associated with your booth. Please remember that most are volunteers and make this event possible.

Vendor Information Package

Upon arrival, Vendors must report to the registration table at the large roll up door on the side of the building. Please pickup your vendor package, which will include your name tags, show information and receipt.

Signage:

You must not affix anything to the walls or floors. Any damage to the walls or floors by affixing items will be the sole responsibility of the vendor to cover the costs of repairs.

Table Covering:

Each table must be covered to the ground by a table cloth/covering. This is the responsibility of each vendor.

Electricity:

There is limited electrical outlets available both inside and outside the building, and will be given out by chance. If you **absolutely require** electrical, please indicate below. We will try and accommodate requests, but **cannot guarantee electrical** at this time. Extension cords are the sole responsibility of the vendor.

Booth Setup:

Friday, July 1, 2022, Noon until 9pm.

Vendors, please come to the hall and join us at the large roll up door on the side of the building to check in. There's plenty of parking, but please be prompt in unloading your vehicle and moving it out of the way. Empty vehicles will not be permitted to sit by doors.

Saturday, July 2, 2022, 7AM until 10AM (show opening). All vendors MUST unload your vehicles by 9:30AM. ALL setup MUST be completed by 10:00 AM and all materials MUST be removed from the aisles, fire exits and doors PRIOR to show opening.



Parking:



Friday, July 1, 2022 - Please move your vehicles away from the loading doors immediately upon completion of unloading.

Saturday, July 2, 2022 - Upon completion of unloading at the front door, your vehicle must be IMMEDIATELY moved to the designed vendor parking lot. This will be strictly enforced. If you're unloading past 9:00 AM, Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest reserves the right to ban you from future events.

Insurance: All vendors are required to provide a copy of the Proof of insurance stating that they hold a minimum of \$2 Million General Liability Insurance and \$250,000 Tenant Legal Liability insurance. Vendors must include the Muskoka Yarn & FibreFest as additional insured for the duration of the Fibrefest. The information required is as follows:

COVID19 Reality: There is always a chance that lockdown measures can be changed by the Health Unit, and we would be forced to cancel the show.
